

"WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT TO DO?"

SERMON SUMMARY

In this sermon, we explore the story of the Israelites trapped between the Red Sea and Pharaoh's approaching army. The sermon highlights how God intentionally led His people into what seemed like an impossible situation to display His glory and power. It also emphasizes the importance of trusting God's plan, even when we don't understand it, and the assurance that God is with us in our most difficult times. Through the Israelites' experience, we learn valuable lessons about facing our own challenges with faith and confidence in God's deliverance.

KEY VERSES

Exodus 14:13-14 (NLT) -

"But Moses told the people, "Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. ¹⁴The Lord himself will fight for you. Just stay calm."

Psalms 46:10 (NLT) -

"Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world."

QUESTIONS

1. Have you ever felt like you were in a situation with no way out? How did you respond?
2. What does it mean to you that God might intentionally lead us into difficult situations?
3. How can we balance acknowledging our challenges while keeping our focus on God?
4. Why is it important to be more concerned with God's glory than our own relief?
5. How can earnest prayer change our perspective during tough times?
6. What are some practical ways to stay calm and confident while waiting for God to work?
7. Can you share a time when you saw God's deliverance in your life or someone else's?
8. How can we encourage each other to trust God when facing the "Red Seas" in our lives?
